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

- ET 2020 provides common strategic objectives for EU member countries:


"An average of at least 15 % of adults should participate in lifelong learning."

Adult participation in learning (%) in 2016 **Top 10** countries




- EU 28 average 10,8 %

CHARTER ON LIFELONG LEARNING

Term "lifelong learning"

- First-time education for disadvantaged groups
- Continuing education and training for well-qualified graduates
- Post-retirement opportunities for cultural enrichment

Universities commit to:

- Embedding concepts of widening access and lifelong learning in their institutional strategies.
- 2. Providing education and learning to a **diversified student population**.
- 3. Adapting study programmes to ensure that they are designed to widen participation and attract **returning adult learners**.
- 4. Providing appropriate guidance and counselling services.
- **5. Recognizing** prior learning.
- 6. Embracing lifelong learning in quality culture.
- 7. Strengthening the relationship between **research**, **teaching and innovation** in a perspective of lifelong learning.
- Consolidating reforms to promote a flexible and creative learning environment for all students.
- 9. Developing **partnerships** at local, regional, national and international level to provide attractive and relevant programmes.
- 10. Acting as **role models** of lifelong learning institutions.
