

Kuyper's philosophy about education

- Education should have its own autonomy

awareness!




- Conduct research
- Write, revise, publish papers-CHASING citations (rather than trying to change the world)
- Go to conferences
- Give presentations

LEADS TO: individualistic approach vs. teamwork, competitive attitude vs. collaboration, junior position vs. leader in research team-hierarchy vs. reciprocity



- Structuring the PhD process and trajectory allows to *raise awareness* of the relevance of societal engagement beyond common PhD **tasks**



Marketing, promotion and recruitment

- Improved recruitment process for PhDs- explicit information on expectations, beyond traditional academic skills

Challenges

- Strong *support-acknowledgment-drive* by the university leadership
- Early adapters among Deans, PhD coordinators, Graduate School/Doctoral School Heads
- Skepticism among traditional research directors

Key messages

1. Societal engagement is also a state of mind – teamwork with society, reciprocity with society.
2. Raising awareness and creating socially engaged mindsets by integrating varied activities that challenge the traditional academic path throughout the PhD trajectory-structuring.
3. Changing traditional academic minds needs support from the university leadership (*initiators* or *supporters*).
